Dear Mr. Benedict:

I am writing to clarify the status of the site plan approval issued by your office for this project.

As you indicated in your letter of November 14, 2003, some uses for our proposed expansion were exempted by the State from zoning because of their agricultural nature and the remaining uses were permitted by right and required the submittal of a site plan. Based on that understanding, we submitted a site plan application to your department on October 8, 2004 and received an approval letter on November 22, 2004.

Prior to this approval process, an Environmental Assessment (EA) was submitted to the State Clearing House, as required of State projects of this size. The EA was approved in April, 2003. An Environmental Impact Statement was not required by the State Clearing House. Mr. Robert Davis from your office requested a copy of our EA, which we provided to him in November of 2005.

Our direction from State Clearinghouse is to revise the approved EA to include all the portions of the site plan that were approved by your office in November 2004; the original EA included only some of the buildings that were approved in your site permit. We are aware of Orange County's Environmental Impact Ordinance (EIO), but as stated in the State Environmental Policy Act, we not subject to the EIO because we are neither a private developer nor a special-purpose unit of government. We will continue to comply with the submission procedure established for EA's related to state property and we will provide you with a copy of the revised EA we are preparing for the State Clearinghouse.

To clarify a final point raised by Mr. Davis, trees, limbs, stumps and construction debris will be disposed of according to the solid waste management plan of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Since our original check for the \$1307 review fee was never deposited, and was therefore voided by the State, we are resubmitting that check with this letter.

We believe that this information satisfies the questions raised by Mr. Davis concerning our approved application. If you have any additional questions, please feel free to contact me.

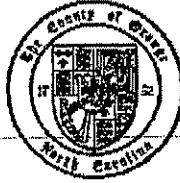

The zoning of the property is AR (agricultural residential); Haw River Watershed – Unprotected.

The requests for the uses as described in the attached executive summary are classified as University Uses (P23) pursuant to our Zoning Code Section 4.3. of the Permitted Use Table. Some uses are likely to be exempted by the State from zoning because of their agricultural nature. Therefore, the remaining uses are permitted by right and require the submittal of a site plan pursuant to Article XIV of our zoning code. (See enclosed)

The Orange County Planning & Inspections Department has reviewed and approved the UNC School of Medicine, Research Resources Facility Expansion Site Plan. Said expansion includes the following:

- 11,000 s.f. Rodent Retention Facility
- 8,850 s.f. Blood Lab
- Tow 5,000 s.f. dog kennel to support the existing Canine Research Facility;
- 1,500 s.f. office associated with the new kennels;
- 1,000 s.f. storage facility for the new kennels;
- 15,000 s.f. kennel and lab area to support the new Blood Lab;
- Five (5) new pig enclosures @ 4,800 s.f. each; and
- Additional parking and pedestrian walks; and

The next step in the approval process is to obtain the necessary approvals and permits.
